OVERVIEW

EXPOS3D is an immersive art experience that pushes the boundaries of traditional exhibition formats. Created by internationally acclaimed artist Trevor Jones, **EXPOS3D** blends classical oil painting, sculpture, stained glass, and digital media with cutting-edge technologies including AR, AI, facial recognition, and blockchain.

Set within the historic Custom House in Leith, Edinburgh, the exhibition explores themes of surveillance, faith, and rebellion in the age of algorithms. Viewers are invited not just to observe, but to participate—becoming part of the artwork through responsive installations and immersive storytelling.

This Beta version of **EXPOS3D** is both a fully realised exhibition and a testbed for the larger 2026 iteration. It offers a rare glimpse into a future where physical and digital art co-exist and evolve in real time.

ABOUT THE ARTIST

Trevor Jones is a Canadian-born, Scotland-based artist renowned for pioneering the fusion of traditional fine art with emerging technologies. With a background in oil painting and a passion for experimentation, Jones rose to international prominence in the Web3 space through record-breaking NFT sales and high-profile digital exhibitions. He has exhibited at Sotheby's and Christie's and has work in the collection of MOCO Museum (London/Barcelona/Amsterdam).

EXHIBITION HIGHLIGHTS

Visitors to EXPOS3D can expect a boundary-breaking mix of:

- Oil paintings, including the monumental Adam and Eve triptych with Al live video streaming
- Augmented reality overlays that bring static artworks to life
- Al-driven paintings that react to viewers in real time
- Sculptures and stained glass works enhanced with digital layers
- Facial recognition, motion sensors, and Web3-linked storytelling
- NFT integrations that connect physical and digital ownership

This Beta version serves as a prototype for the full-scale 2026 international exhibition. It's a fully immersive, curated environment designed to test audience interaction and tech integrations*.

Key Works:

- Adam and Eve A massive triptych depicting the biblical figures in a dystopian, Al-surveilled world, symbolising consent, exposure, and rebellion.
- The 7 Sacramemes A provocative series of oil paintings fusing sacred iconography with meme culture, graffiti, and Al-powered facial/emotion recognition.
